DIGITAL IMAGES

HOW TO SUBMIT:

1

Save your image files and rename them consecutively as they have been cited in the text;

2

Use author's initials to rename the image files (or key-words of the title) following a numerical order;

(ex: gastrect01, gastrect02, gastrect03... ou ASouza01, ASouza02, ASouza03);

3

TIFF (ex: gastrect01.tiff) or BMP (ex: gastrect.bmp)

are the best file formats.

JPEG ou JPG may reduce the quality and high resolution of the image.

4

Scan images at a resolution of 100 dpi

(300 dpi is the best option)

5

Submit a diskette or CD only with the image files for a better resolution quality

(do not embed them in your manuscript).

The BJVS team may assist you publishing your manuscript illustrations.

Do not forget to follow these important steps for a high quality print out of your manuscript!
